



Twenty First Sunday After Pentecost Reformation Sunday

Receiving the Light, Being the Light, Sharing the Light of Jesus Christ



In the reading from Leviticus, the law of love is laid plainly before the Hebrew people. In the gospel lesson from Matthew, Jesus emphasizes that the greatest commandments are, first, to love God, and, second, to love your neighbor as yourself. In this proclamation, Jesus makes clear that such love Is connected—you cannot properly love God without loving your neighbor.
