# August 14, 2016 Thirteenth Sunday after Pentecost RECEIVING THE LIGHT, BEING THE LIGHT, SHARING THE LIGHT



Today's passage from Hebrews shares about Biblical heroes that ran the race of faith with perseverance and endurance. The text reminds hearers that followers of Christ, though they may face hardship, will prevail with their eyes fixed on Jesus. The lesson in Luke is replete with images of strife and division. Jesus expects complete allegiance, and he speaks to the cost of such discipleship while also redefining the contours of family. For Christians, baptism is the new mark of family.
