

First Sunday of Advent

Receiving the Light, Being the Light, Sharing the Light **COMMUNION SUNDAY**



Today we enter the season of Advent and the beginning of the church's liturgical year. Advent is the time we anticipate the coming of our Savior, Jesus Christ, both as the incarnate Christ-child, and his future coming to reign in glory. In this morning's Scripture readings, the prophet Isaiah directs Israel to look for the coming King, and the apostle Paul calls us to lay aside the works of darkness. In Matthew's Gospel, Jesus urges us to be watchful and spiritually awake for the second coming of the Son of Man will come at an unexpected hour.
