



On this fourth Sunday of Advent, the Scripture readings point to the faithful responses of God's people as they await their coming Savior, Jesus Christ. The psalmist cries out to the Lord for the restoration of God's people, faithfully anticipating the coming Shepherd of Israel. Matthew's Gospel shines light on Joseph's righteousness. He is unwilling to expose Mary to public shame and is also obedient to God's instructions. Joseph's grace and faithfulness are powerful and allow God's story to continue to the birth of Jesus, our Emmanuel—God with us
