

Sixth Sunday after the Epiphany RECEIVING THE LIGHT, BEING THE LIGHT, SHARING THE LIGHT



Psalm 119 is often known as a love song to the law. In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus renews Israel's understanding of the law. In the reading from the Gospel of Matthew, "do not judge" refers to making the kind of judgements within the community of Jesus' followers that only God can make. The golden rule reminds us of how Jesus taught us to treat others.
