Third Sunday after the Epiphany
RECEIVING THE LIGHT, BEING THE LIGHT, SHARING THE LIGHT



The scripture lessons this morning ask us to consider what it means to follow Christ. The passage from Isaiah contains the promise that "the people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; those who live in a land of deep darkness, on them light has shined." In Matthew's gospel, Jesus proclaims a message of repentance when he encounters Peter, Andrew, James and John, each of whom drop everything to follow Jesus.
