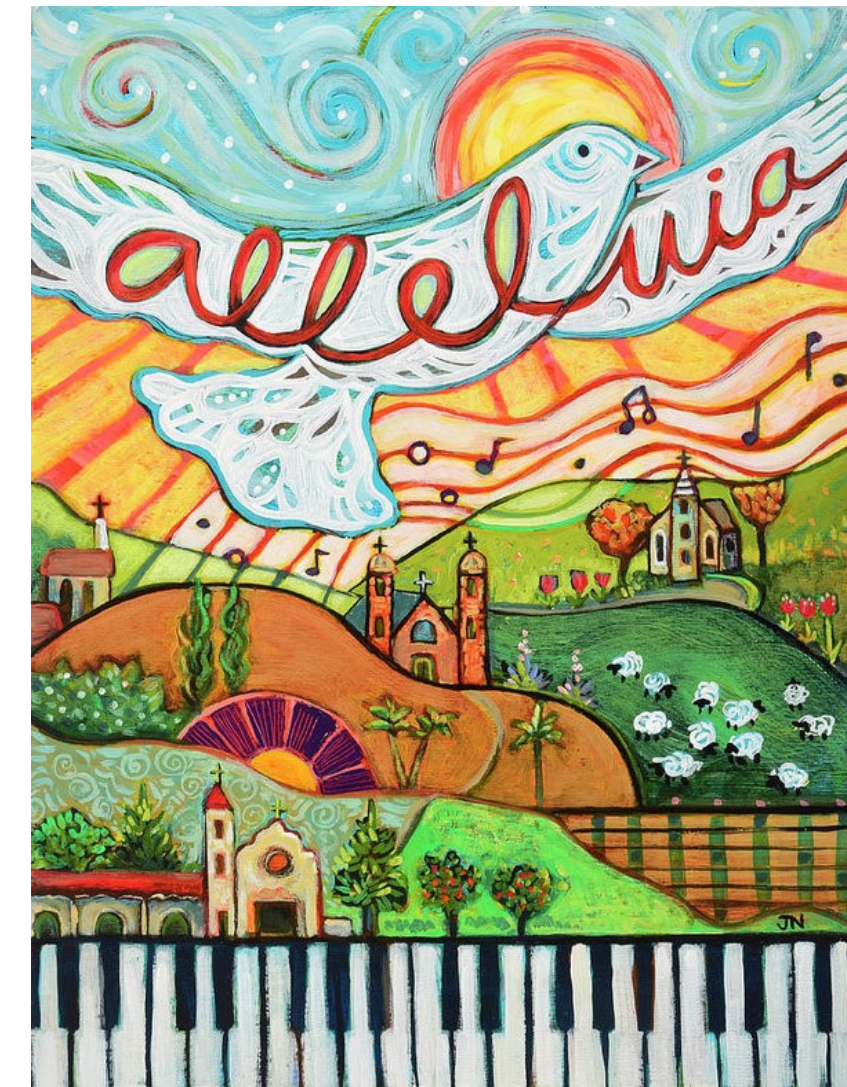

Second Sunday in Lent-Music Sunday
RECEIVING THE LIGHT, BEING THE LIGHT, SHARING THE LIGHT



*"I will sing to the Lord as long as I live; I will sing
praise to my God while I have being." ~ Psalm 104: 33*

Lent is a season that reflects the tension between faith and frailty, hope and doubt. In Paul's letter to the church at Philippi, he expresses grief over those who live as enemies of the cross, who set their minds on earthly things. He encourages instead the heavenly citizenship, where all humiliations are transformed. The Luke passage provides a lens through which to view transformation and healing—a fitting theme for the days of Lent. We also celebrate the Lighthouse Church Music Ministry today in a Celebration of Praise.
