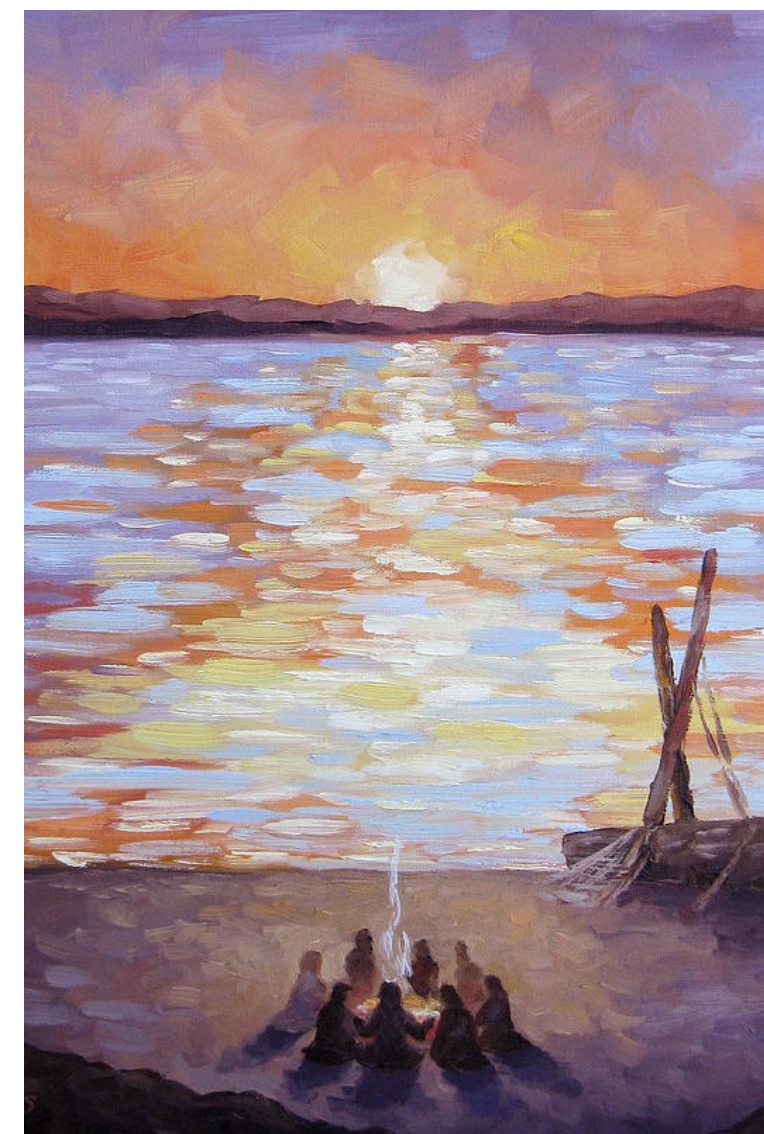

COMMUNION SUNDAY



In today's Gospel passage, the resurrected Jesus makes another appearance to his disciples. Jesus reveals himself through a joyful repeat of a miraculous catch of fish, with Peter diving into the water to reach his risen Lord. Jesus prepares breakfast for his friends, eating and drinking alongside them. He also lovingly restores Peter, who had denied him three times. The passage ends with Jesus challenging them and us to follow him wherever he leads.
