July 31, 2016 **Eleventh Sunday after Pentecost**



The Epistle Lesson from Colossians admonishes us to remember that we are raised with Christ—a new creation. Therefore, we should set our minds on things that are eternal, living into the hope that we will be with Christ. The passage in Luke speaks to the insidious nature of greed and the ways our possessions often come to possess us and prevent us from encountering the true abundance found only in Christ.
