Twenty first Sunday after Pentecost RECEIVING THE LIGHT, BEING THE LIGHT, SHARING THE LIGHT



In Luke, Jesus encounters ten lepers and heals all of them, but only one—the foreigner—returns to offer thanks to God for having been healed. In the passage from 2 Timothy, Paul reflects on his own suffering and encourages endurance in Christ—the one who is faithful, even when we are faithless.
