In today's lesson from Philippians, Paul likens the journey of faith to a race, encouraging the disciples in Philippi to strain forward and press on to the heavenly goal of Christ. All other earthly desires and dreams fall away and are transformed when we reorient our perspective around God's perspective. The parable of the wicked tenants in Matthew is a warning to any who presume they are entitled to salvation by suggesting that many of God's people have not produced worthy fruit for the kingdom.
